No factor at all in the G2 Lexington on synthetic, but he moved back to dirt and ran on decently to be 3rd in the G2 Peter Pan here May 9; still, he was beaten 5 1/2 lengths by Charitable Man and never a factor, and the horse who beat him for 2nd (Imperial Council) came back to run midpack in the G1 Met Mile; maiden win came here at least, but that and all his best work has come sprinting (both wins, both 2nds); today's game couldn't be any different. -Michael Hammersly
