Grade I. Purse \$2,000,000 For Three Year Olds. Lasix not allowed within 48 hours of post time pursuant to HISA Rule 4212. By subscription of \$600 each, to accompany the nomination, if made on or before January 27, 2025, or \$6,000, if made on or before Monday, April 7, 2025. At anytime prior to the closing time of entries, horses may be nominated to The Belmont Stakes upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$50,000 to the New York Racing Association, Inc. \$15,000 to pass the entry box and \$15,000 additional to start. All entrants will be required to pay entry and starting fees; but no fees, supplemental or otherwise shall be added to the purse. The winner of the 2025 Wood Memorial and the top 3 finishers in the 2025 Peter Pan Stakes will have their entry and starting fees waived for the 2025 Belmont Stakes presented by NYRA Bets. The purse to be divided \$1,200,000 to the winner, \$360,000 to second, \$200,000 to third, \$100,000 to fourth, \$60,000 to fifth, \$40,000 to sixth, \$20,000 to seventh and \$20,000 to eighth. Colts and Geldings: 126 lbs. Fillies: 121 lbs. All Belmont Stakes runners must be on the Saratoga grounds by noon time on Wednesday, June 4th. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and groom.
